

# Mother of Dallas Newspaper Man Dies

FORT WORTH, Texas, July 7.—Mrs. Sallie Lou King, 63, widow of the late William H. King, died at her home here at noon Sunday. Mrs. King had been in ill health for months and a decided turn for the worse occurred last Friday.

Mrs. King was born in Greenville, Nov. 12, 1860, and before her marriage was Sallie Lou Hale, daughter of Hugh C. Hale, Hunt County pioneer. Her husband, a pioneer cattleman of West Texas, died last March at the home here.

Mrs. King is survived by the following children: Mrs. James E. Burgess, Mrs. Roy J. Vanham and Mrs. Roy Kelley, all of Fort Worth and J. Wylie King of San Antonio and Oswin K. King of the Dallas Journal.

Funeral services will be held at 10 o'clock Monday morning with the Rev. William Anderson of the First Christian Church officiating. Burial will be in Greenwood Cemetery.
