

JARVIS ESTATE IS DIVIDED EQUALLY

With the purchase by Van Zandt Jarvis of one-third of the interest held by his mother, Mrs. Ida Jarvis, the estate of the late J. J. Jarvis becomes subdivided into three equal parts.

Van Zandt Jarvis paid \$110,000 in the deal recorded Wednesday for one-third of his mother's interest in the estate, which represented one-sixth of the entire estate. This was done to equalize the estate.

Mrs. Linnie Jarvis Burgess purchased the interest of her brother, Dan Jarvis, in the estate in 1915.

Through the Wednesday deal, Mrs. Jarvis, Mrs. Burgess and Van Zandt Jarvis hold equal parts—one-third each.
