Indictment on Charge of Murder—Released Saturday

Jim Burgess, indicted by the grand jury on the charge of murder, gave bond in the sum of \$3,000 Saturday. He gave himself over to the officers prior to the indictment and was under bond when the indictment was returned.

W. J. Garrett, who was indicted on a charge of embezzlement under \$50, the technical charge against him being misdemeanor, was placed under arrest Saturday and released on bond of \$250.
