

# 18 Convicted On Dope Law Go to Prison

Another blow to the illegal narcotic traffic in Dallas and Fort Worth was struck Monday when eighteen federal prisoners, convicted under the narcotic law, were taken to Leavenworth penitentiary from the Dallas County jail among thirty-six sent for various offenses.
