

MRS. COLUMBIA INNES GOES TO LONG SLEEP

Funeral This Afternoon From Home of Maury Kemper.

Mrs. Columbia Davis Innes died yesterday morning at 9 o'clock at the residence of her grand-daughter, Mrs. Maury Kemper, No. 638 Elsmere Park, after a short illness. As she was 77 years old, her death was due, in a large measure, to the infirmities of age.

The funeral will be held from the residence this afternoon at 2:30 o'clock and will be conducted by Rev. Mark Collis of the Broadway Christian church. Interment will be made in the Lexington cemetery.

The pall bearers named are John W. Davis, Maury Kemper, A. R. Pritchett, S. W. Sayre, H. E. Ross and G. H. Barr.

Mrs. Innes was well known in this vicinity, having lived here since her young girlhood, when she became the wife of John P. Innes of this city, who preceded her to the final resting place.

The deceased was the daughter of the late William Davis of Woodford county. Mr. Davis settled in Woodford county a number of years before the war, coming from Orange county, Virginia.

In her old age, as in her youth, Mrs. Innes was one of the most pleasant and lovable women in the county and her death is greatly deplored by a large number of life-time friends.
