

Sam Houston's Daughter Dies At Age of 81

Heart Failure Kills Mrs. Mary Houston Mor- row at Stamford.

ABILENE, Texas, Dec. 14 (AP).—Mrs. Mary Houston Morrow, daughter of Gen. Sam Houston and former Abilene postmaster, died Monday night at the home of a daughter, Mrs. R. E. McDonald, in Stamford. Mrs. Morrow was 81 years of age. Death resulted from heart trouble.

Funeral services will be held here Tuesday afternoon and burial will be in a local cemetery beside the graves of her husband, J. S. Morrow, and a son, John Houston Morrow.

Mrs. Morrow was Mary Willie Houston, fourth child of Sam Houston and Margaret Lea Houston. Born in Huntsville April 9, 1850, she spent her childhood at Huntsville and Independence. She was graduated from Baylor College when it was at Independence and married J. S. Morrow at Georgetown April 11, 1871.

The couple moved to Abilene in 1885, Mr. Morrow, an attorney, coming here for his health. His death oc-
